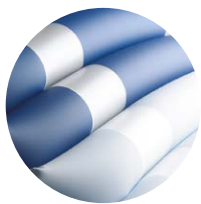


The Auto Logic 200 mattress replacement is part of the logic range from Arjo.

The Auto Logic 200 is designed for round the clock prevention and management of all categories¹ of Pressure Injury with frequent monitoring, nursing intervention and repositioning.

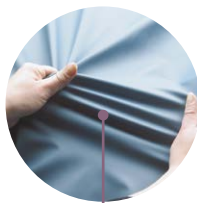
For pressure area management of very high risk patients, the Auto Logic pump uses Self Set Technology to control the mattress pressure in both active alternating and reactive constant low pressure therapy modes, an advanced microprocessor system regularly assess the body mass distribution of patients and readjusts cell pressures to suit their individual needs.

Key features



Cell in Cell (CIC) system

- Centralises patient on the mattress
- Designed to increase stability and to aid with transfer off and on the surface



Cover

- Reliant fabric with welded seams



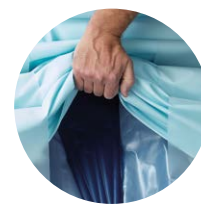
CPR control

- Rapid deflation to assist resuscitation
- Designed for one handed operation
- Positioned at head end



Dual-modality pump

Providing Active (Alternating) pressure mode and Reactive (Constant Low Pressure) mode



Micro air loss

- The micro air loss feature is designed to reduce humidity within the mattress



Battery option

Provides therapy in the event of a powercut or for active transport to the operating or X-ray department



Transport facility

- Simple operation via disconnection of tube-set from the pump
- Provides patient support for up to 12 hours



AutoFirm

Provides a temporary stable support surface to assist patient transfer and other nursing procedures
